Discussing how to develop a culture of Teacher Ownership and Teacher Leadership with the Teacher Growth Model

The Teacher Growth Model (TGM) serves as the professional learning roadmap that guides Singapore educators towards achieving the five desired Teacher Outcomes. The TGM has been updated to incorporate pedagogical frames, digital literacy, STEM, sustainability, peer support, and learning beyond education.

On 15 February 2024, the TGM team from the Academy of Singapore Teachers (AST) engaged newly appointed School Staff Developers (SSDs) in a professional learning experience to help them learn how to support the holistic growth of their teachers through the TGM. SSDs also engaged in a lively exchange of ideas to build their teachers' capacity as a reflective practitioner, and to promote Teacher Ownership and Teacher Leadership. They also were made aware of the useful resources in the TGM Wiki that can be used to support teacher professional learning and mentoring.

The SSDs expressed their appreciation for the valuable insights gained from the session, particularly in using the TGM to guide teachers in their professional learning and to support the attainment of their school's strategic plan for staff capacity building.
